School Activity Challenges

Promoting core in-school entrepreneurial activities and with the larger community.

Project Meeting Challenges

Meetings and definition of the work plans including stakeholders involved in the entrepreneurial school project



Company/ Incubator Visit Challenge

Bring classes to companies and entrepreneurs to the classroom.



Idea/Job Plan Challenge

Hold an Idea or Job Plan Competition in the school with the participation of external stakeholders (Business/Social/Gov't.)

Entrepreneurship Day / Global Entrepreneurship Week Challenge

Promote cross curriculum entrepreneurship with a dedicated day or week to projects, ideas and career choice. Participate and contribute to Global Entrepreneurship Week (GEW) activities.



Entrepreneurship Stand Challenge

Stand up and make the schools voice here! Communicate, having both physical and virtual (online) spaces announcing the entrepreneurial activities in the school.





School Development Challenges

Developing new competences and skills to led, teach and assist students in entrepreneurial education.

Teacher Training & School Leadership Challenge

Investing in teacher training and developing leadership competences for the entrepreneurial school with a focus on internal processes and resources



In-House Workshop Challenge

Developing internal workshops to further dialogue on the development of entrepreneurial school.



Entrepreneurship Strategy Challenge

Developing an entrepreneurship strategy for the schools with an action plan involving different stakeholders.

Fostering engagement with community stakeholders and entrepreneurial activities at schools.

Social Entrepreneurship Challenge

Support social ventures through developing student awareness, knowledge and participation in social entrepreneurship
